### **Seminar on Competition Law and Policy for the OECS Sub-Region Radisson Beach Resort, Grenada 16 September 2019**

The CARICOM Competition Commission wishes to announce that there will be a one-day seminar on competition law and policy for the countries of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS) on **16<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at the Radisson Beach Resort in Grenada.**

Based on the request of the OECS Members, the Commission is embarking upon a technical assistance strategy that would seek to build awareness and promote implementation of competition law and policy in the OECS sub region. This strategy will be phased across a three (3) year period and will seek to address the needs of various target audiences in separate training events – public sector, private sector and judicial and legal officers.

The CARIFORUM Directorate has agreed to partner in this initiative of strengthening sub-regional economic cooperation and integration and will be sponsoring the attendance of the participants from the OECS sub – region to the meeting. The OECS Secretariat and the Ministry of, Government of Grenada are our co-hosts for the meeting.

The aim of this year's event is to build the capacity of technical persons from Ministries responsible for competition and consumer enforcement within the sub-region. The training facilitators of the workshop will be from the US Federal Trade Commission (USFTC) and the CARICOM Competition Commission.
